Entry Sign Update

At the May 2007 Del Cerro HOA annual membership meeting, interest was expressed in a new "monument style" stone entry sign. In August residents were polled on their sign preferences (including the existing wooden signs) and were asked to vote on which, if any, of the 4 plywood mockups they liked best. In all, 43 residences participated and 39 viewed the mockup alternatives. The winner was a 4-ft. sign with a tapered stone base supporting a wood beam-framed wood sign as shown in the mockup photo. The cost of the new sign (approximately \$6,000) will be covered by City Beautification Grants, \$3,000 this year for the footing & base structure and \$3,000 next year to

add the stone veneer and sign. This year's grant was approved in October and necessary permit applications will be submitted to the City soon.
