- Take the Pacific Coast Highway exit and drive West to Vermont Avenue.
- Turn South (left) on Vermont.
- Follow Vermont for one mile to the "five corners" light at Anaheim/Gaffey Streets. At this
 intersection, bear slightly right onto Palos Verdes Drive North.
- Follow Palos Verdes Drive North up the hill for two hundred yards and turn left into campus
 at the first opening in the median (soon to be named Rolling Hills Prep Way).
